2019 AFA CONFERENCE RED PACK RRP \$834 YOUR PRICE \$265 (INCL. \$40 DONATION)
Contains 2 each of:
MARTINS VINEYARD LIMITED MCLAREN VALE SHIRAZ 2016 (RRP \$150.00) <i>97pts Sam Kim, 95pts James Halliday + more</i> You could call this the Back to the Future Shiraz. It is relatively low alcohol and features American oak yet has stunning intensity of blue and black fruits with absolutely no overripe characters. It is neither the heaving, jammy and over oaked behemoth of old, nor the modern, perfumed pretty which is in favour at the mo. On paper it could be a trainwreck but somehow it pulls together a bit like that old tune which still pops up from time to time ... something old, something new, one to follow, fruited blue. And maybe black too.
RICHARD HAMILTON CENTURION SHIRAZ 2018 (RRP \$80.00) This is a brilliantly concentrated wine full of layers of flavour, texture and richness. Halliday's ratings for the previous 10 vintages read thus ... 97, 97, 95, 96, 97, 95, 96, 95, 96, 95... and this is as good as the very best vintage produced to date, perhaps a smidge better. Produced from a heritage plot of 120+ year old McLaren Vale vines, it will cellar 30 years plus.
CHATEAU YALDARA RESERVE GRENACHE SHIRAZ MATARO 2015 (RRP \$55.00) <i>92pts James Halliday, 91pts Kim Brebach</i> Lots of red and blue fruit purity here. There's blue and confectionary from the Grenache, along with brooding darkness and grunt from the Mataro. Smoke, olive and spice to boot and a fresh finely tannic finish.
CURTIS CAVALIERE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2015 (RRP \$70.00) <i>94pts James Halliday, 94pts Tony Keys, 94pts Sam Kim + more</i> A superb first release Cabernet under the Curtis Cavaliere label and as good as you'd expect if you've had the Shiraz previously. Lots going on here, with chocolate, spice, cedary oak and lots of fine tannins. Decant for an hour or so if you want to try it now or stick it in the broom closet for up to 10 years.
MANSER 'DAD'S BLOCK' SHIRAZ 2017 (RRP \$30.00) <i>94pts Sam Kim, 92pts Kim Brebach, 91pts James Halliday, 91pts Wine Showcase</i> A brilliantly structured wine light enough on its feet to drink now. Alternately hide it for up to a decade. Plenty of spice, hints of cocoa and chocolate here along with blue and black fruits. Modern and delicious.
HASTWELL & LIGHTFOOT BARBERA DAL VALE 2016 (RRP \$32.00) Soft and slippery Barbera offering prune, spice and an easy generosity of ripe red and blue fruit flavours. Mid-pallet richness is brought into balance but just the right kick of acidity. Length is good and the flavour hangs around after you have swallowed.

BIRD IN HAND SPARKLING PINOT NOIR 2018 (RRP \$25.00) It's an unusual wine this one with enough fruit and sweetness to keep the occasional wine drinker happy and enough quality fruit to shift curmudgeonly wine snob from miffed to mollified. Pleasures best by itself but suspect it would be all over the turkey if given a sniff.
CLAYMORE JOSHUA TREE WATERVALE RIESLING 2018 (RRP \$22.00) <i>95pts James Halliday, 93pts Kim Brebach</i> A properly stunning example of a Clare Valley Riesling. Zesty floral and citrus aromas lead to fine boned acid and minerality. Little wonder Windsor Dobbin rates this edition as one of the best Rieslings from all of the Clare Valley.
MASSENA 'FRUIT SALAD BLOCK' FIELD BLEND 2018 (RRP \$28.00) <i>93pts Campbell Mattinson</i> As Campbell Mattinson and Mike Bennie have said in separate reviews... 'What a ripper'. From the famous Stonegarden vineyard in the Eden Valley. This white is made from seriously old vines and perhaps as many as 20 different varieties including Riesling, Muscat, Verdelho, Grenache and Mataro. There's minerality, chalkiness, stone fruits, spices and all manner of other deliciousness going on. Indeed, this is a ripper.
HITHER & YON PETIT BLANC 2017 (RRP \$26.00) Light, shiny and briny with musk on the go too. There is lemon here too and a lovely floral perfume. Chill it hard and have with an Asian salad or laksa. This will stand up nicely to a bit of chilli fire.
SERAFINO RESERVE CHARDONNAY 2017 (RRP \$25.00) This is a perfectly balanced chardonnay offering minerality, seductive mouthfeel, stonefruits, citrus and French oak. McLaren Vale can make Chardonnay which challenges the Adelaide Hills, Mornington, Margs etc for quality - this wine is proof.
RIPOSTE 'THE FOIL' SAUVIGNON BLANC 2018 (RRP \$22.00) <i>92pts Kim Brebach</i> EN GARDE! Winemaking legend Tim Knappstein is responsible for this Sauvignon Blanc. Aromas of snow pea, fresh cut grass and passionfruit dominate the nose with the palate showing traditional crisp minerality and piercing acidity. Perfect pairing for oysters!
